RESOLUTION NAMING MONMOUTH COUNTY BRIDGE S-17  
AS THE "SENATOR JOSEPH M. KYRILLOS, BRIDGE"

WHEREAS, Monmouth County Bridge S - 17 spans the Swimming River and connects Middletown and Red Bank; and

WHEREAS, Bridge S - 17 is colloquially known as "Hubbard Bridge" since it begins at Hubbard Street in Middletown; and

WHEREAS, the long-standing 340 foot long W. Front Street bridge over Swimming River was determined to be structurally deficient and functionally obsolete; and

WHEREAS, the new 488 foot long steel girder bridge consists of 6 (six) 80 foot spans supported on pile bents and pile supported abutments; and

WHEREAS, an average of 21,000 vehicles cross the bridge on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, the original budgeted cost of \$14 million was insufficient to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, Senator Joseph M. Kyrillos, recognized the critical need to replace the structurally deficient bridge and the attendant need to secure funding; and

WHEREAS, Joseph M. Kyrillos, was instrumental in securing the supplemental funding in the much needed amount of \$7 million to complete the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth hereby name Monmouth County Bridge S - 17 the "Senator Joseph M. Kyrillos, Bridge".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senator Joseph M. Kyrillos, Bridge shall have an appropriate plaque affixed on the structure.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the clerk shall forward a certified true copy of this resolution to the Governor of the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey State Senate, the Mayor and Council of Middletown, the Mayor and Council of Red Bank, County Counsel, the County Engineer, and the County Administrator.
